Cyber Resilience Act (CRA) Compliance Status Statement

1. Purpose

This statement provides customers and partners with the current status of Ocean Data Systems (ODS) activities relating to Regulation (EU) 2024/2847, the Cyber Resilience Act (CRA), for ODS software products that fall within the scope of the Regulation.

2. Regulatory Status

The CRA applies in stages. Article 14 reporting obligations apply from 11 September 2026. The main product cybersecurity, conformity assessment and manufacturer obligations apply from 11 December 2027. Article 14 also applies to products with digital elements placed on the EU market before 11 December 2027 when those products fall within the scope of the CRA.

3. ODS Current Compliance Status

ODS has established a formal CRA compliance programme and internal product-security processes covering vulnerability intake, PSIRT assessment, Article 14 escalation, remediation follow-up and evidence. The internal Article 14 workflow has been implemented and tested. Production ENISA SRP access is verified for the Primary Assigned Representative, including creation and retention of a non-submitted Early Warning draft. No test regulatory notification was submitted.

Work toward the requirements applicable from 11 December 2027 is ongoing, including cybersecurity risk assessment, secure development, vulnerability handling, software component and dependency management, product security documentation, support-period requirements and applicable conformity-assessment documentation.

4. Compliance Statement

As of 15 September 2026, ODS considers its CRA compliance programme to be in progress and aligned with the regulatory milestones currently applicable. ODS has operational Article 14 reporting access through the ENISA SRP and continues implementation of the requirements applicable from 11 December 2027. ODS does not claim that final CRA conformity has already been established for every ODS software product.
